A description of parental rights

Peaceful Games won't require a child to disclose more information than is reasonably necessary to participate in our games.

Parents can review their child's personal information, direct Peaceful Games to delete it, and refuse to allow any further collection or use of the child's information.

Parents can agree to the collection and use of their child's personal information, but still not allow disclosure to third parties.
